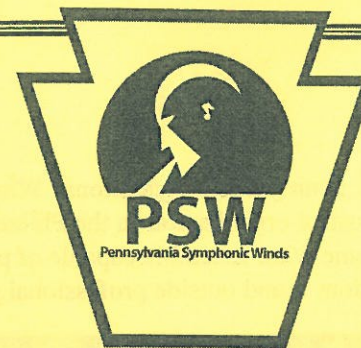

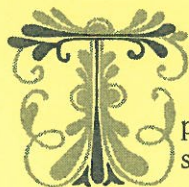

The Pennsylvania Symphonic Winds is a new and unique musical organization in the Philadelphia area. It is a symphonic wind ensemble capable of playing a caliber of music seldom found outside professional groups.



This outstanding ensemble was organized in late 2008 and is comprised of 47 professional and dedicated semi-professional members under the direction of its founder, Mr. Philip Evans, current Bandmaster at Valley Forge Military Academy and College in Wayne, PA. Mr. Evans is a native of the United Kingdom who honed his musical skills during twenty-four years' service with The Band of Her Majesty's Royal Marines. The Winds' repertoire runs the gamut from transcriptions of the world's greatest symphonic music, to world-class contemporary concert band literature, to film and theater music, to original compositions and arrangements.
